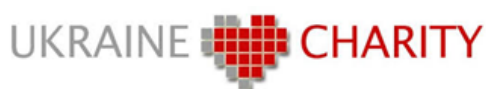

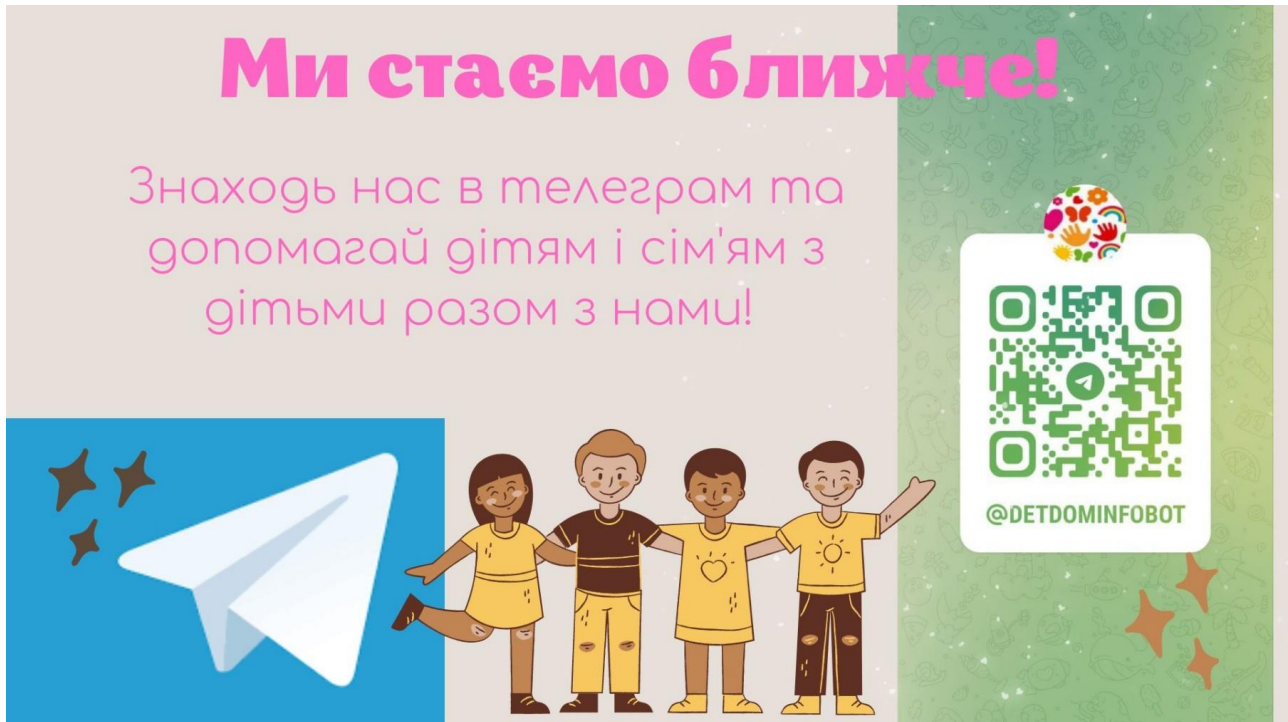

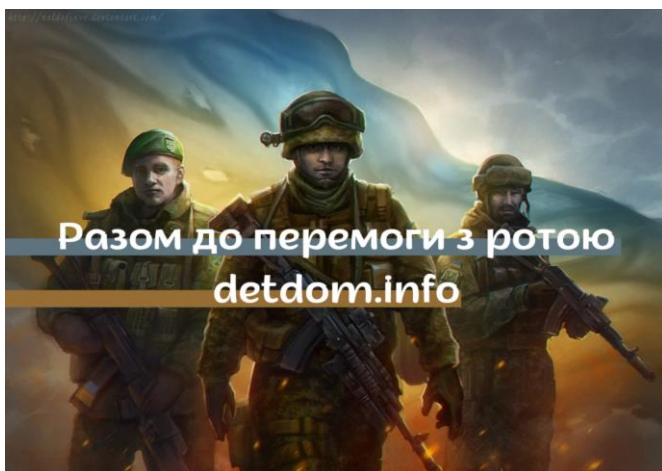
We are in Telegram

Battalion detdom. info. "Our defenders"



At the time of the outbreak of war, the organization maintained contact with 20 orphans who perform military service under contract and are in units that are involved in active hostilities. Some of them have an officer rank or are students of higher military educational institutions. At the end of the year, the project covered more than 30 of our defenders.

Boys who have the status (of an orphan child or a child deprived of parental care) up to 23 years old may not perform military service, but real life, for which they are mostly not ready, leads them to military service, where they find themselves in conditions similar to those



which they are accustomed in an orphanage - clear rules, regime, provision of basic needs, social guarantees, financial stability. But there are guys who dreamed of being military from school and purposefully achieved their goal after graduation.

We are proud not only of our defenders, but also of philanthropists who united in the face of the terrible face of war! Together with our regular friends and patrons, ordinary people, volunteers and simply caring people joined the project, who transferred funds, bought equipment, including abroad and handed them over to our defenders.

Special attention was deserved by the boy Matvey, who transferred almost all his savings to purchase a machine gun maintenance kit for our defender.

Project to support a boarding school graduate and a child from a family with difficult life circumstances "Successful start"

After leaving the boarding school for young people, one of the most difficult periods of their lives begins. This is a transition from the usual, regulated and practically closed life in a boarding school to real life, in which they have to make decisions independently and bear responsibility for them.

In the first year after leaving the boarding school, graduates face problems related to the choice of educational institution, housing, job search, budget planning, organization of life, food and free time, interaction with society, etc.

One of the effective forms of assistance to graduates is the Successful Start project. About the project "Successful start" was launched in 2019 and provides support for a particular graduate at least during the first year of study or throughout the study.

2022 has been a big challenge for our participants. Children from the occupied territories, from places of hostilities, almost all managed to leave for safe places. It should be noted that all the time we were in touch with them and provided support. But Mykola T., who was in Donetsk region, was helped to go abroad during forced displacement. An important point of the project is financial support (scholarship). Usually it is 1000 UAH / month. and is designed for the academic year (10 months). At the beginning of the war, almost all our participants found themselves in a difficult financial situation, therefore, thanks to the support of philanthropists, detdom.info scholarship was increased (1500-2000 UAH/month). and extended payments in the summer.

From March-April, online learning resumed in all institutions, and from August-September, institutions resumed their work and conduct classes in a mixed type.

In 2022, 67 participants took part in the project. Of these, 4 children dropped out due to non-compliance with the terms of the program. 6 children became graduates of institutions and our project: 2 of them are already working in their specialty, 2 have gone abroad, 1 is in the ranks of territorial defense, the fate of 1 participant is unknown (according to unverified information, he returned home to the occupied territory).

Vitaliy K., 19 years old - a graduate of a boarding school in the Kyiv region, studied at the Katyuzhan Vocational School as a cook-waiter. Vitalik diligently treated all his studies, systematically attended classes. On December 30, 2022, Vitaliy successfully completed his studies and received a diploma of cook and waiter. The following assistance was provided: scholarship support; consultation and treatment of the dentist was carried out; Vitaliy's family received a food set. Active participation of volunteers*.

Ihor K., 19 years old - a graduate of a boarding school in the Kyiv region, studies at the Skvyra Higher Vocational School as a car repairman. Igor is diligent in his studies, a kind and smart guy. The following assistance was provided: scholarship support; hygiene products were transferred; consultation and treatment of the dentist was carried out; Igor's family received a food set. Active participation of volunteers.

* A volunteer is a person who becomes the curator of a group of graduates, or an individual graduate, during the participation of children / children in the project "Successful Start".

Masha Ya., 17 years old - an orphan, two years ago my mother died. He studies at the Kyiv Transport and Economic College of the National Transport University, specializing in tourism. Responsible attitude to learning, one of the best students of the group. Has artistic abilities. The following assistance was provided: scholarship support; Hygiene products, stationery were transferred.

Vladimir G., 20 years old - a graduate of a boarding school in the Ternopil region, studied at the Ternopil Higher Vocational School No 4, majoring in bricklayer, plasterer, tiler. In March 2022, Volodymyr successfully completed his studies and joined the ranks of the defense industry. The following assistance was provided: scholarship support.

Nadia G., 18 years. - from a large family. Nadia, a student of the Kyiv Higher Professional School of Sewing and Hairdressing, specialization chef-pastry chef. Kind, well-mannered and purposeful girl. She plays the piano and sings beautifully. Assistance provided: scholarship support; Transferred Stationery and hygiene products.

Oleh S., 17 - from a family with difficult life circumstances. He is under the care of his grandmother. He studies at Nizhyn College of Culture and Arts, majoring in folk music. Oleg is a talented accordion player, and his teachers emphasize this.

Assistance provided: scholarship support; Hygiene products, clothes and shoes were donated.

Anastasia I., 18 years old - a graduate of the boarding school of the Kiev region, studied at the Skvyra Higher Vocational School as a cook-waiter. In May 2022, Nastia dropped out of school and dropped out of

the project.

Vlad P., 19 - a graduate of a boarding school in Kyiv region, studied at the Skvyra Higher Vocational School as a tractor driver. In June 2022, Vlad graduated.

Ruslan K., 16 - an orphan, a graduate of a family-type orphanage in Donetsk region. He studies at the Kramatorsk Center for Vocational Education No. 47 as an electric and gas welder. He plays the guitar, has many hobbies, is attentive and very courteous.

Assistance provided: scholarship support; mobile phone for online learning was transferred.

Mykola T., 18 years old - an orphan, studies at the Kramatorsk Professional College of Industry, Information Technology and Business of Donbass State Machine-Building Academy, specializing in technician-programmer. At the beginning of the war, thanks to our volunteers, Mykola managed to go abroad, where he continues his studies online.

Assistance provided: scholarship support; As the best participant of the first academic semester, the young man received a laptop.

Nastya K., 17 years old - from a family of LWD, studies at the "Interregional Center for Jewelry Art" in Kyiv as a jeweler. He has many hobbies. She graduated from music school, plays the piano well, attended art school and loves to draw, is fond of psychology.

Dmytro's hobbies are football. He is a member of the football team of Kmytlvska boarding school, has repeatedly participated in competitions, has awards.
Assistance provided: scholarship support.

Ilona S., 16 years old The new participant 2022 is a graduate of a boarding school. From a large family of LWS. With his father, the relationship does not add up. She entered the Berdychiv Vocational Construction Lyceum as a seamstress. He likes to embroider with beads and help his mother in the garden.

He entered the Kiev Regional Higher Vocational School of Construction, specialty car mechanic, straightener Bodies. He is passionate about cars and music. His dream is to repair cars.

Paul J., 16 years old New participant 2022 - from a large family (7 children). Until recently, he lived at home, but his relationship with his stepfather did not develop and there was a desire to live independently. Now he is setting up life in a dormitory. He studies at the Kyiv Lyceum of Transport as a cook. He likes to draw, skateboard, stunt bike and cannot imagine his life without music. Assistance provided: scholarship support; Hygiene products and stationery were transferred.

Volodymyr P., 18 years old New participant 2022 - Volodya's mother is deprived of parental rights, so the guy spent most of his life with his grandmother, who has now suffered two strokes. On the shoulders of Volodya lay the responsibility to care for the old woman. Volodya is a student of the Educational Scientific Center for Vocational Education of the National Academy of Pedagogical

Sciences, specialty mechanic for the repair of wheeled vehicles. He is fond of extreme sports: stunt bike, rollerblades.

Assistance provided: scholarship support; Hygiene products and stationery were transferred.

Volodymyr K., 19 New participant 2022 is an orphan, parents were deprived of their rights when the boy was still small. For some time he was under guardianship, but it did not work out there and at the age of 12 he finally ended up in an orphanage. After school, Volodya graduated from the lyceum as a computer debugger, but now he decided to radically change his specialty and this year entered the Chernihiv Pedagogical University at the Faculty of Physical Education. Loves everything Repair. Assistance provided: scholarship support; clothing, hygiene products and stationery were donated.

Alexander O., 16 years old New participant 2022 - from a large family, mother raising five children on her own. The guy studies at the Skvyra Higher Vocational School, masters the specialty of a tractor driver. Since childhood, he has been interested in technology, especially loves to repair cars. He also loves fishing.

Assistance provided: scholarship support; Clothing, food, medicines, hygiene products were donated.

Ilya K., 16 years old new participant 2022 - from a large family of LWD. Recently, a tragedy occurred in the family, due to the negligence of parents, three children died. Ilya suffered this tragedy very hard. The young man studied at the Skvyra Higher Vocational School, specialty mechanic in car repair. In November 2022, Ilya was expelled from school and dropped out of our project.

Assistance provided: scholarship support; Clothing, food, medicines, hygiene products were donated.

Maxim D., 16 years old new participant 2022 - from a family of LWD, mother is hearing impaired. Maksym also has a serious illness - epilepsy. Maxim is a student at the Skvyra Higher Vocational School, studying as a car repairman. The guy's hobby is cycling.

Assistance provided: scholarship support; Clothing, food, medicines, hygiene products were donated.

Alexander G., 16 years old new participant 2022 - from the family of LWD. Parents do not have a permanent job. Relations do not develop with stepfather. He studies at the Skvyra Higher Vocational School as a tractor driver. Sasha is very sociable, loves physical education and communication with friends.

Assistance provided: scholarship support; Clothing, food, medicines, hygiene products were donated.

Diana I., 15 years old new participant 2022 - from a family of LWD (6 children), mother on maternity leave, stepfather lost his job.

The girl is studying at the Skvyra Higher Vocational School as a cook-waiter. Diana has diverse hobbies: dancing, singing, embroidery and drawing.

Assistance provided: scholarship support.

Marina K., 16 years old New participant 2022 - from the family of LWD, mother is very sick, all household chores fall on the shoulders of the girl. He studies at the Skvyra Higher Vocational School as a cook-waiter. He draws beautifully and is fond of his future profession.

Assistance provided: scholarship support.

Alexey P., 15 years old new participant 2022 - from the family of LWD, father died, mother alone raising 5 children. He studies at the Skvyra Higher Vocational School as a cook-waiter. The main hobby of the young man is cooking. From a minimum of products can make a good and tasty dish.

Assistance provided: scholarship support.

Alexander K., 16 years old new participant 2022 - from the family of LWD. The family has 7 children, the mother is on maternity leave. He studies at the Skvyra Higher Vocational School as a tractor driver. A thrifty guy, the main assistant to his father in the household.

Assistance provided: scholarship support.

Tatyana K., 15 years old new participant 2022 - Tanya's mother died a few years ago. The father is raising two children on his own. He studies at the Skvyra Higher Vocational School as a cook-waiter. He loves to sing and is fond of cooking.

Nastya S., 15, new participant 2022 - has the status of an internally displaced person. All her life she lived in Druzhkivka, Donetsk region. The war forced the family to flee to Kyiv. This year, Nastia entered the Educational Scientific Center for Vocational Education of the National Academy of Pedagogical Sciences as a secretary of the head. The girl loves to read, read a lot of fiction.

Assistance provided: scholarship support.

Yaroslav K., 16 years old New member 2022 - In August of this year, Yaroslav's mother died. There was an older brother who could not take custody of the guy. Now Yaroslav is under the care of the school. The guy is studying at the Educational Scientific Center for Vocational Education of the National Academy of Pedagogical Sciences for the specialty of a mechanic for the repair of wheeled vehicles. Yaroslav's main hobby is sports.

Assistance provided: scholarship support.

Yevhen Ya., 15 years old new participant 2022 - from a large family, has IDP status. The family was forced to move to Kyiv. Yevhen is a student of the Educational Scientific Center for Vocational Education of the National Academy of Pedagogical Sciences, specialty locksmith for repair of wheeled vehicles. He is fond of football, is a fan and loves to drive the ball himself.

Assistance provided: scholarship support.

Peter L., 17 years old New participant 2022 - from a family of LWD, mother raising children on her own. The guy is studying at the Educational Scientific Center for Vocational Education of the National Academy of Pedagogical Sciences of Ukraine, specializing in wheeled vehicle repair. Smart and active guy.

Assistance provided: scholarship support.

Alina H., 16 years old New participant 2022 - from a large family. He studies at the school with his older sister Tatiana. During the fighting in Zhytomyr region, the girls' family lost their home. Alina studies at the Educational Scientific Center for Vocational Education of the National Academy of Pedagogical Sciences of Ukraine, specializing in the secretary of the head. Calm, shy, loves nature.

Assistance provided: scholarship support.

Tatyana Kh., 19 years old New participant 2022 - from a large family. At the school he studies with his sister Alina. During the fighting in Zhytomyr region, the girls' family lost their home. Tanya studies at the Educational Scientific Center for Vocational Education of the National Academy of

Pedagogical Sciences at the Faculty of Information, Library and Archival Affairs (junior bachelor's degree), specialty office manager. Tanya is fond of photography.
Assistance provided: scholarship support.

We support our graduates in difficult moments of life

At the beginning of last year, a disaster happened in the family of Vlad P., his mother tragically died. The guy was in despair, did not even have a penny to bury his mother. We are grateful to our volunteer Dmytro K. for material support and Tetiana O. for the moral support of the boy.

We also continue to support our graduate Dmytro I., who has been serving his sentence in prison for the second year. For reference: in December 2020, Dima returned home drunk, his stepfather was in the same condition. There was a quarrel and the guy picked up an ax and struck his stepfather several times. In the end, he survived, but the guy had to answer for his act. During the current year, Dima was repeatedly sent parcels with food and hygiene products.

Project "Internship for Skvyra School"

Skvyra Higher Vocational School has long been our partner. Children from families with difficult life circumstances, large families, graduates of boarding schools study in this institution. The teachers of this institution have not only high-quality professional skills, but also, most importantly, humanity and a desire to help children successfully integrate into life.

Successful development of the profession involves the passage of practical training. Unfortunately, the school does not receive funds for such needs, that is, the purchase of fuel, products, uniforms, even books and manuals falls on the shoulders of the students themselves. Of course, we know that this situation is familiar to most families with child students. But the wards of "Successful Start" are children who can only count on a scholarship in the amount of 350 - 500 UAH. Unfortunately, without our support, they are forced to dominate only theoretical and knowledge.

In December 2021, thanks to the support of the British charity organization Ukraine Charity, this project was launched and 30 children became its participants. Before the outbreak of hostilities, the following assistance was provided:

Since July 2022, the school began to gradually return to work and industrial practice. In July-August, the remnants of already purchased materials were used.

Since October, the war has again begun to make adjustments to our lives. The conduct of industrial practice was in jeopardy due to blackouts. It was decided to purchase a generator and barbecue for the school. The children continued to learn professional skills.



Project "I want to learn"



DBST Raranchuk "Lack of light will not interfere with gaining knowledge"

Today, the majority of children are in family-type orphanages, have a lag behind the scaleflax program that makes them not competitive upon admission to higher educational institutions. This factor is due to the fact that the child spent some time in a boarding school or lived in a family with difficult life circumstances and did not have the opportunity Get quality education. Only once in the family environment, children begin to look at the world with different eyes and their talents and inclinations are revealed. Raising 10-15 children, parents do not have the opportunity to help everyone catch up with the program and gain the necessary knowledge for admission to higher education institutions.

To fill gaps in training, gain new and improve already acquired knowledge, the project provides additional classes with tutors.

At the beginning of 2022 , 10 family-type orphanages (43 children) took part in the project. Unfortunately, since February, with the outbreak of full-scale hostilities, the implementation of the project has been stopped. In September 2022, it became clear that the project is more relevant than ever, because online learning and a shortened program will not provide in the future the knowledge that children need to successfully integrate into society. Currently, 7 family-type orphanages (40 children) have continued to participate.

A lot of effort was spent on pulling children up from school. This is a huge help. Contributing to the future of children. Thank you so much! »*

Olena Yusan, mother-educator: *"We immediately saw the result of the work. Children also like it when they feel that they can and succeed, there is a desire to work.*

Elena, teacher of English language (DBST Bondar): *"We worked at full strength. Despite the fact that children are difficult, with certain diagnoses, almost everyone always did their homework and seemed to absorb everything they heard. Almost everything that was planned for these months was fulfilled."*

Yana, teacher of English language (DBST Raranchuk): *"In general, I am very pleased with the work with these children. Exercises were done, homework was done. The best results were shown by Bohuslava, a capable girl. Milan and Anya are a little worse, but not bad at all."*

Lisa, Shevchenko English teacher: *"I am very happy about the success, especially of older children. Masha and Taras, children studying in the 7th grade of the 5th, did not even know the letters. Now they read and translate freely. Milan, the youngest child, loves to learn poetry, declares them with pleasure and understands what is at stake."*

Project "Storming boarding schools"



"An old friend is better than a new two"

At the beginning of the war, there were a large number of children from boarding schools sent home, Because Most of them are social orphans, that is, children who have parents, but for various reasons are forced to live in boarding schools. Most of the institutions close to the contact line, where orphans were evacuated abroad and to safe territories of Ukraine.

The evacuation also continued from the territories that had already been captured by the enemy. Many of our active volunteers were also forced to flee the war. All this made it impossible to communicate closely with the wards of the children, but they are

still trying to meet online. In spring, initiative volunteers of the Radomyshl Navigators group helped the families of their wards with food sets.

Since September, the boarding schools have resumed their work, most of the children have returned, but the only group of volunteers who resumed their trips is the "Kmitov Navigators". *"I cannot fully understand life now: how they can go down to the shelter every time in alarm - day and night. Among the pupils there are children who cannot dress on their own, someone does not walk or does not speak, most have an unstable mental state, and next to them there should always be an adult who will help and calm down. Teachers are on duty for months on a volunteer basis - instead of one, which should remain out of state, three people spend the night in the boarding school,"* says the curator of the group Oksana.

The volunteer group tries to visit the children every month, but the emphasis of the trips has changed slightly. Many residents of the orphanage were under occupation in the spring, these are the places where the Russians tried to capture Kyiv from the north, first of all, psychological support and a sense of security are now important for children. Therefore, volunteers decided to conduct classes with children that have an art therapy direction.

Humanitarian Aid Project



The activities of detdom.info are focused on helping children and families who usually need help and support due to difficult life circumstances. In addition, these are large families and family-type orphanages (DBST). Today, most of these families have lost the opportunity to provide for themselves at the minimum level that was before the war, and some are even on the verge of poverty. Families who suffered as a result of the war, lost their homes and moved to other cities - internally displaced families - also need urgent assistance now. Therefore, now one of the directions of our work is to provide food sets, medicines, baby food, hygiene and detergents for children and families seeking such help.

In 2022, our team provided assistance to **136 families, which is 329 children**. In addition, 78 boarding school graduates (participants of the Successful Start project) also got help.

From our families we receive not only requests for help, but also sincere words of gratitude.

"Now is a difficult time and every parcel from you is a serious support for me as a single mother," says Khrystyna, a graduate of the orphanage who is raising her son on her own.

Project " RIGHT TO HEALTH"



Quality medical services for orphans

The project "The Right to Health" provides diagnostic, medical, preventive and counseling assistance to orphans and children left without parental care, graduates of boarding schools, children from low-income families and family-type orphanages, and we also began to provide medical assistance to our defenders, who today defend the independence and freedom of Ukraine. During the project, we have established partnerships with doctors and medical clinics of various profiles. Thanks to such cooperation, during 2022, 23 children and 1 participant of the Our Defenders project received 30 quality medical services free of charge, including:

- 14 dental services
- 9 ophthalmological consultations
- 1 orthopedic consultation
- 1 neurologist consultation
- 2 consultations of an ENT specialist
- 1 consultation of a gastroenterologist
- 2 operations for the correction of strabismus
- 1 pediatrician consultation
- 3 laboratory tests (testing, MRI examinations)

Medical institutions and doctors - partners of detdom.info

The project involves 13 medical institutions and 9 doctors, in 2022 6 medical institutions have been added, which have become our partners. The geography of the partnership has also been expanded, 2 clinics from Bila Tserkva have joined the project.

Dental and vision problems remain the most frequent requests of the project. We are especially grateful for the constant cooperation of the ophthalmological center "Aylaz", dental clinic "MamaDentist" and "DD Clinic", medical laboratory Nikolab. We sincerely thank the new partners who willingly agreed to cooperate with us, these are the National Children's Specialized Hospital of the Ministry of Health of Ukraine "Okhmatdyt", namely the Head of the Department of Pediatric Ophthalmology Barinov Yuriy Viktorovich, the Center for Endocrine Medical, the Smart Medical Clinic, the Polyclinic in Darnitsa, the Famili Dent Dental Clinic, the Doctor Optics Clinic.

Projects launched in 2022

Project "There will be something to sow - there will be something to eat"

80% of FTCTs reported on detdom.info (327 families in total) are located in rural areas. Neviddillon the component of such families is a farm or homestead farm. This year, sowing a field and planting currants is a matter of survival not only for an individual household, but also for ensuring food security of the country as a whole.



Because of the war, Ukraine is losing acreage, and the risk of disruption of the sowing campaign is especially threatening. Active hostilities, mined fields, the outflow of farm workers into the ranks of the Armed Forces of Ukraine and territorial defense, the destruction of agricultural machinery - all this hits the country's food security. Therefore, we consider it extremely necessary to support the FTS with rural funds. They all have their own farm, land plot and plan to expand the sown area.

"My husband is a tractor driver, we have a dream to have our own tractor, harrows and everything related to agriculture. It will be a great help for us and we could cultivate even more fields," says Oksana Sheletytska, mother-educator of the FTST. The project provides for the provision of agricultural machinery to 9 DBST.

Shelter Equipment Project



Most of the institutions where children are brought up today have been moved to safer places. But we are very concerned about the fate of specialized children's institutions, where there are children with complex diseases, complex developmental disorders and requiring special conditions of transportation, special transport, appropriate medical personnel nearby. Many of these establishments are located in an area where rocket attacks are frequent.

There are boarding houses in which shelters are either not equipped at all, or their condition is unsatisfactory: ventilation is faulty or absent, there are no seats and beds either. Children in such institutions are different categories of children with disabilities, there are children who are in bed all the time, there are those who move in wheelchairs, or with the help of the staff of the institution. Therefore, we want to draw attention to the fact that it is in these institutions in war conditions that it is extremely important to equip shelters. We have calculated a project for the arrangement of a shelter in the Zhytomyr Regional Specialized Orphanage for orphans and children left without parental care and the Teterevsky orphanage of Zhytomyr OR.

Project "Firewood in the house - support for the family"



Now it is very difficult to survive in extremely difficult war conditions, when a significant part of the country's territory is under constant shelling, when critical infrastructure facilities are damaged and continue to be under fire - electricity and heating networks, boiler houses, when residential buildings and social premises are left without heating and lighting. Today, a stove, rough, wood-fired or pellet cauldron can help Ukrainians survive the most difficult winter in the history of Ukraine. A large number of our families live in rural areas and therefore it is imperative to lend a helping hand to them in such a difficult time. Yes, we receive many requests

about the need for firewood from such families, namely 8 families are waiting for help.

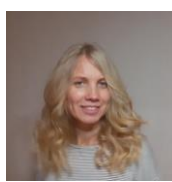
